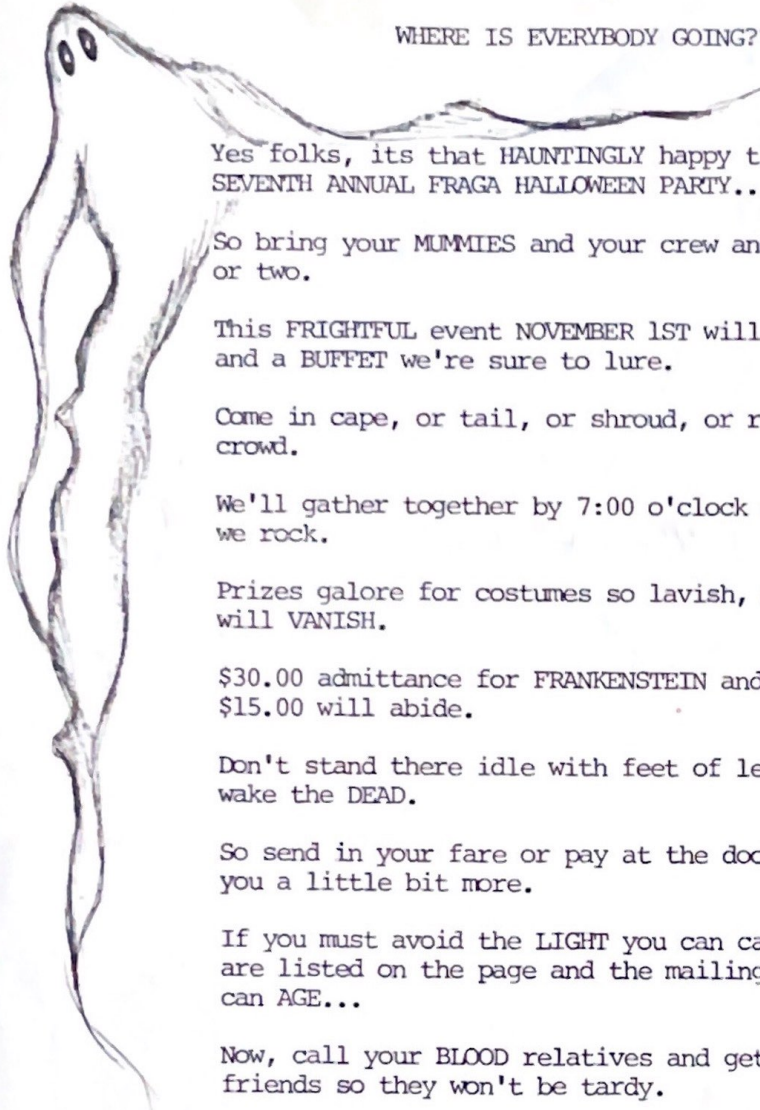

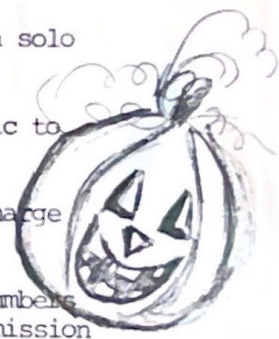

Maximum number of Visitors - 143 vehicles x 3.5 people (500 total)

Size of Shelter - 31' x 32'

Maximum number of Tables under Shelter - 20; other tables in area

Maximum number of People under Shelter - 20 tables x 8 people (160 total)

Electrical - 2 100 volt outlets available under Shelter

Water - 1 Drinking fountain and hand pump well available at site

Restrooms - Attached to Shelter; Men's and Women's flush toilets with hand dryers

Note! Additional Port-a-johns may be required if you exceed the 500 capacity.

Cooking - 13 small barbecue grills and 1 large portable grill (4' x 2') provided

Play equipment - slides, swings and climbers located west of the shelter.

Two Horseshoe pits in area - stakes and horseshoes are NOT PROVIDED

Ball fields - the area is large enough to play softball and other field games

Fire circles - 3 in area; bring your own wood or wood can be provided at EXTRA COST
(Contact Park Supervisor)

Alcoholic Beverages are permitted EXCEPT at Swimming Beach (please bring unbreakable containers)

NO MOTORCYCLES are ALLOWED IN PARK; Parking area is available at Contact Station

Pets must be on Leash (6' maximum); No pets allowed in Beach Picnic Area or at Swimming Beach

This shelter is located near the start of our Nature Trail system and offers open areas for field games. It's location provides maximum privacy from the rest of Park users. It is about 3/4 miles from the Beach and Boat Rental. Life Jackets must be worn at all times while in boats. No gasoline motors are allowed on Crooked Lake. All boats rented must be boarded from the Boat Rental Building. Children under 16 years of age must have an adult sign out their boat and be under adult supervision.

Price of Shelter Rental is \$175 PLUS ENTRANCE FEE PER VEHICLE at \$3 PER CAR. All shelter rental rates are 1/2 price after Labor Day through October and from April to Memorial Day Weekend. The shelters are not rented from November through March. All rental must be paid in advance to confirm the reservation. Refunds will only be issued before 90 days of the confirmed reservation date. A rain check will only be issued if it is compatible with the Park's rental schedule.

Our reunion will be held at **Moraine Knoll**. We have access to the entire park, which includes a beach, nature trails, paddle boats on Crooked Lake, along with fishing. Enclosed you will find a map of the park. You may bring your own boat or canoe. No gasoline motors or windsurfers.

Rental Fees:

Row boats, canoes: \$10:00 per boat for all day which is refunded when the boat is returned

Row boats, canoes: \$3:00 per hour

Paddle Boats: \$3:00 per 1/2 hour. There is no all day rental.

Fish stocked in Crooked Lake: pike, rock bass, perch, sunfish, blue gills

Swimming is allowed on the beach. Lifeguard on duty.
